Register for the 2007 ESD Michigan Regional Future City Competition, held in conjunction with National Engineers Week

The Future City Competition is a team-based program—consisting of at least 3 students, a teacher and an engineer mentor—that fosters an interest in math, science and engineering through hands-on, real world application. The process helps students better understand the practical applications of mathematical and scientific principles.

Future City teams:

- design a futuristic city using SimCity™ 3000 software.
- write an essay and abstract.
- build a futuristic city scale model using recycled materials.
- prepare an oral presentation about the highlights of their futuristic city.

Models and Presentations are judged at the ESD Michigan Regional Future City Competition in January.

In February, the winning Michigan team receives an expense-paid trip to Washington, DC, to compete in the national finals for a chance to attend Space Camp.
